Sad news



Some of you may already be aware of how this works but if it is new to you, there will be a letter coming home explaining how to log in and set things up for you and your child at the beginning of next week.

Class Dojo will be the school's primary form of communication, allowing direct communication between you and your child's teacher and any adults who support your child in school. We have started to introduce the digital platform to the children this week and they have been very excited to begin receiving their Dojo points for good effort, attitude, and behaviour.

Please can I reassure you that we will be available in the coming weeks to support you with how everything works and help set things up if you come across any technical hitches in the early days. This will replace google classroom.
