#### **Learning Habits**

I spoke with the children in assembly on Monday about what it means to be a 'Responsive' Learner and all week we have been awarding Dojo points to children who have been actively engaging in their learning through:-

- Careful listening and responding to questions being asked
- Asking their own questions about their learning
- Independently seeking answers and problem solving
- Staying focused and participating actively in the lessons


