Remembrance

Odd Sock Day

Next week is anti-bullying week. This is always an excellent opportunity to highlight our 'Zero tolerance to Bullying' approach here at Weeth School. On Monday we will be taking part in the Anti-Bullying Alliance 'Odd Sock Day'. Everyone is invited to wear odd socks to school! It's an opportunity to encourage people to express themselves and celebrate their individuality and what makes us all unique!

If your child would like to design an Anti-Bullying poster at home and bring it into school next week that would be wonderful.



Nits!

We have seen an increase in the number of case of nits / lice. Please can we ask you to check your child's hair this weekend. One of the most effective ways of treating and preventing nits is wet combing.

Lice and nits can be removed by wet combing. You should try this method first. You can buy a special fine-toothed comb (detection comb) online or from pharmacies to remove head lice and nits.

There may be instructions on the pack, but usually you:

- wash hair with ordinary shampoo
- apply lots of conditioner (any conditioner will do)
- comb the whole head of hair, from the roots to the ends

It usually takes about 10 minutes to comb short hair, and 20 to 30 minutes for long, frizzy or curly hair.

Do wet combing on days 1, 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched head lice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17.
