Year 1 : News

What a fantastic workshop we had with Beach Guardian on Monday. There were three different activities, looking at the main roles of Beach Guardian.

One station was the 'Activist' station, raising awareness of the effects of plastic pollution in the sea and on the beaches. The children created their own posters to raise awareness.

The next station was the 'Research' station where children had the opportunity to use a microscope to look closely at the different plastics that had been collected.

The third station was the 'Marine Biologist' station, here we learned more about micro plastics, pyro plastics (plastics that have been burned) as well sea 'fangles' and mermaid purses.



Mental Health Champion Training

On Wednesday morning, four children from Year 5 and 6 took part in the Mental Health Champions Primary training at Camborne Science and International Academy. This exciting new training programme will teach children how to stay mentally healthy and give them the skills and tools to be more resilient.

We have got lots of fantastic ideas, on what we can do in Weeth to support the mental health of our pupils, that we need to share with Mrs Craig. These include a stress bin for each class, good grounding techniques and how we can positively control our emotions (especially when we are feeling stressed or anxious).

Next week, we will meet to discuss what we can do in school for the upcoming Children's Mental Health Week (week beginning 6th February).





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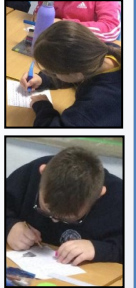

We are pleased to announce that Weeth CP School has organised a clothes & shoe collection with Bag2School in order to raise funds for PTA funds.

Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 2001 it has now paid out over £36 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for Weeth CP School, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.
