Message from Mrs Peacock

What another fantastic week we have spent together at Weeth with some amazing learning taking place and lots of Dojo points being earned by all.

This week it was great to see the return of clubs and I for one really enjoyed seeing children from all classes in my singing club this week. I hope that the children have enjoyed the choices that they made. Please do not hesitate to contact the school office if you need any further help with this.

No one could have been more surprised than me on Tuesday when I opened my eyes to see pictures of the snow in Camborne. What an exciting start to the day! Thank you all for your patience as we organised arrangements for the safe opening of the school. Our main priority as always is to keep everyone safe. After a late start nearly all the staff and many of the children did indeed make it to school in one piece.

As you may be aware one of my roles at school is Attendance lead and this week, I have spent some time monitoring attendance across the school. Attendance and absence data is analysed regularly to identify pupils or cohorts that need additional support with their attendance, and the school uses this analysis to provide targeted support to these pupils and their families. Over the next week, you should receive a letter with your child's attendance for the autumn term. Some families will receive an additional letter as their child's attendance is currently below 95%. Please do not worry if you receive this letter and your child was off due to a medical reason. Children do get ill, and many children were ill at the end of the Autumn term. Be reassured we do not want ill children sent to school. Most children's attendance is great. I would like to thank parents for their support with this.

We are pleased to announce that Weeth CP School has organised a clothes & shoe collection with Bag2School in order to raise funds for PTA funds.

Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 2001 it has now paid out over £36 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for Weeth CP School, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.
