On Tuesday afternoon Year 1 went for a short walk to the post office in preparation for creating their own map of the local area in Geography. We spotted the road names and walked very sensibly.













Year 5: News - Trip to Nexus

On Monday, we took part in a science workshop at Nexus. During the workshop, we were asked to separate salt from rock salt for some fish and chips. First, we used a pestle and mortar to grind the rock salt. We then added this to water to dissolve the salt. Then, we poured the solution (salt and water) into a funnel containing filter paper to filtrate the solution. Once the solution was filtrated, we poured this into a dish on top of the Bunsen burner. We then used heat to evaporate the water. Eventually, this left behind salt!

We were amazed to see that we could retrieve salt from the rock salt and loved trying out the Bunsen burners in a real science lab.


