Year 1 : News - Out and About

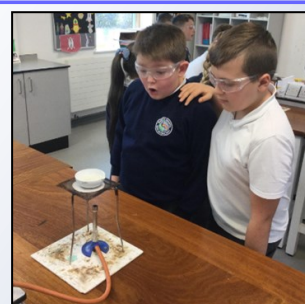
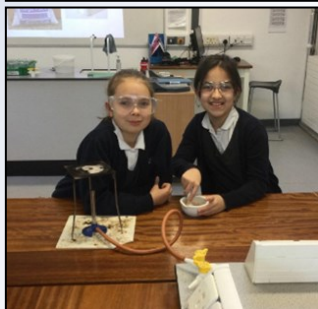
On Tuesday afternoon Year 1 went for a short walk to the post office in preparation for creating their own map of the local area in Geography. We spotted the road names and walked very sensibly.



Year 5 : News - Trip to Nexus

On Monday, we took part in a science workshop at Nexus. During the workshop, we were asked to separate salt from rock salt for some fish and chips. First, we used a pestle and mortar to grind the rock salt. We then added this to water to dissolve the salt. Then, we poured the solution (salt and water) into a funnel containing filter paper to filtrate the solution. Once the solution was filtrated, we poured this into a dish on top of the Bunsen burner. We then used heat to evaporate the water. Eventually, this left behind salt!

We were amazed to see that we could retrieve salt from the rock salt and loved trying out the Bunsen burners in a real science lab.



Year 6 : News - Visitor from Geevor Mine

This week, Clint from Geevor Tin Mine visited Year 6 for an exciting outreach workshop, where pupils were given the opportunity to handle historic mining equipment and artefacts. We had a brilliant time!

We are pleased to announce that Weeth CP School has organised a clothes & shoe collection with Bag2School in order to raise funds for PTA funds.

Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 2001 it has now paid out over £36 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for Weeth CP School, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.

By getting involved in our **Bag2School** collection, you have an opportunity to sort through your cupboards and wardrobes and donate unwanted textiles in a black bin bag - this can include adults' and children's clothes, shoes (tied together please), hats, belts, handbags and soft toys.
