Year 3: Class News


Our inspirational person for this term is Sir Isaac Newton. For our inspirational day, we made wigs so we could look like Isaac Newton. We found out a lot

Please also do not block the car park entrance, park on any of the yellow lines, yellow zig zag lines or in front of any of the schools access gates/pathways.




