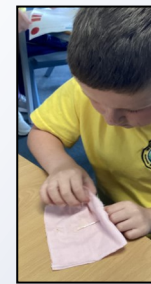
Mental Health Awareness Week

1. GET READY
2. PEAT FREE COMPOST
3. PLANT YOUR SEEDS

Put enough compost in your pot to fill it to the top the press it down to 1-2cm below the rim.

You will need:
A few (not all) of your seeds
A bit of peat free compost
A pot (8")
Water
