#### **Mental Health Awareness**

Looking after our mental health is always a priority here at Weeth, so it was lovely to be able to shine a special light on it this week as part of Mental Health Awareness Week. We started the week with a special assembly where we explored this year's theme of 'Anxiety', and considered what this means. It was a good opportunity to think about all our feelings and challenge some of our thoughts about whether certain feelings are positive or negative. I was very impressed with some of our Year 6 children who felt that under certain circumstances, anxiety is a good thing as it can help improve or sharpen your performance! We also spent time highlighting ways to support our mental health and different activities that can help us reduce or manage anxiety. Here are just a few of the ideas the children came up with: Being in nature, getting outside for a walk, physical exercise, mediation, painting or art activities, doing a craft, listening to music, breathing techniques, and most importantly – HAVING SOMEONE TO TALK TO! I am pleased to say that every child in school was able to name someone they felt they could talk to if they were worried or anxious about something. Good messages here for the adults as well as the children 😊.

We have a very supportive and active group of governors who support us here at Weeth. I am delighted to welcome and introduce our new Chair of Governors, Mrs Karen Brookes, who was elected at our most recent Governors meeting. 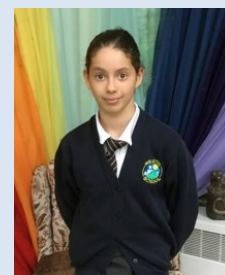




## REMINDERS
