## Let's Grow!

**Growing Together Cornwall CIC**

1. GET READY  
You will need:  
A few (not all) of your seeds  
A bit of peat free compost  
A pot (8")  
Water

2. PEAT FREE COMPOST  
Make a hole, 2cm deep, in your compost, pop a seed in and cover with compost

3. PLANT YOUR SEEDS  
Put enough compost in your pot to fill it to the top the press it down to 1-2cm below the rim.

4. Place your pot on a warm windowsill and make sure the compost stays moist.  
**After 4 to 12 days you should see your baby plant start to emerge!**
