Family circumstances change all the time. If you feel that you may be eligible for free school meals, please take the time over the summer to apply via the link. Apply for free school meals and pupil premium - Cornwall Council or forms are available at the school office. Even if your child is in Reception, Year I or Year 2 and therefore already receives a free school dinner, it is still important to check out whether you can apply for 'Pupil Premium' as this enables the school to access extra funding to support your child. School meals are going up to £2.66 from Ist Sept (£13.30 per week) and it is important to remember that if your child is moving into Year 3, they will now have to pay for their school meal. If you need any help or advice with this, please don't hesitate to ask.

And several parents have approached me about re-launching the PTA this year. We will be holding the first PTA meeting, for any parents who would be interested in helping to organise fund raising events throughout the school year, during our first few weeks back at school. I will post a reminder with times and dates but if anyone is interested, you will be very welcome to ioin us \odot




