RAAC update

You may have seen recent news stories about some schools having structural problems because they were built using Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC).

I am happy to say that all Crofty Schools have been thoroughly checked earlier this year and none were built using RAAC. If you have any questions or queries about this please do not hesitate to get in touch.

School Closure

You will already be aware that the school is closed on Friday 6th October for a Crofty Inset Day. We have had confirmation this week that the school will be used as a polling station for the upcoming local by election for the Treswithian Ward on Thursday 5th October and therefore will be closed on this day too. We are really sorry for any inconvenience caused by this and have made every effort to explore other suitable venues for this to take place but have been advised that the situation is unavoidable.

We have therefore decided to use Monday-Wednesday as an opportunity to teach the children about the British Value, Democracy and hold our own elections for the children's School Council. We will set up the hall as a voting station with ballot boxes and teach the children about how to vote for their own class representative to sit on the School Council. We apologise again for any inconvenience caused but look to use it as a valuable learning opportunity for the children. Please be reassured that we will be continuing our communication with Cornwall Council about being able to find another suitable venue for future events.

Great Start

We are so impressed with the number of children and families who took up the opportunity to complete the Summer Reading Challenge at the local library, thank you. As you know, developing a love of reading is one if the highest priorities here at Weeth and it has been fabulous to see how many children have already been reading at home and recording in their reading journals.
