### Dr Bike's free cycle safety check!

As part of the Cornwall Active Travel programme at Weeth Primary School, Sustrans will be holding a Dr Bike day on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March, to make sure that children and staff have a roadworthy bike in time for Spring and the start of the Big Walk & Wheel.

We will be at school all day to do free safety checks and minor repairs. If there are any major repairs that need doing, we will complete a report so you can take it to a local bike shop for repair and tell them exactly what needs to be done – this saves time and money!


All pupils and staff are welcome to bring their bikes in on the day and we will check as many as possible.

Please note that your brakes may feel sharper after adjustment. We would recommend testing them before riding your bike.

Please make sure that your bike is left unlocked if you would like us to carry out a safety check.

Big Walk & Wheel 2024

Weeth Primary School is taking part in the Big Walk & Wheel (BW&W) from 11<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> March. The BW&W is the UK's largest active travel challenge with over 1600 schools taking part. On each day of the challenge, schools compete to see who can get the highest percentage of their pupils walking, scooting and cycling to school.

During the two-week challenge, Helen from Sustrans will be coming in to deliver the following activities for the children.

**Monday 11th March**

**Dr Bike**  
This is a chance for all teachers and pupils to bring their bikes to school and make sure they are safe to ride. Helen will perform a free safety check with basic repairs.

Please make sure that you leave your bike unlocked if you would like it checked.

**Tuesday 12th March**

**Active travel breakfast**  
Walk, cycle or scoot into school and collect a free, healthy breakfast. If you have no alternative but to come by car, try and park at least 5 mins away and walk the last bit.


**Playground obstacle course**  
Helen will be setting up a fun obstacle course in the playground. The course will be suitable for any child with a bike (without stabilisers) or scooter. If you don't have access to either, they will be able to run around it.

**Bikes & Scooters** – Please make sure that any bikes or scooters are safe to ride. See the attached M-check and L-check guides. Helen will check all bikes and scooters before each session but will not have time to do major repairs. If you think there might be a problem with your child's bike, bring it to the Dr bike on Monday so it can be checked over.

**Helmets** - Your child must wear a helmet unless you provide written permission, so please make sure that they bring one with them. It should be correctly adjusted so it sits squarely on their head, should cover their forehead and not be able to slip off. If you don't have a helmet, the school may be able to provide one and I will have a couple of spares.

**Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March**

**Balance bikes**  
All the children in Foundation will have an opportunity to take part in during the day. Please bring a helmet if you have one.
